Why We Exist?

We want to be a group of St. Mary's parishioners who are visible, active, prayerful, accessible, and informed on life issues. In addition, we wish to effectively promote the culture of life and oppose the culture of death in our society, especially in how the latter finds expression in the activity of the abortion industry, human embryo killing for research and physician assisted suicide. We also oppose Federal government interference with our free conscience rights.

Typical Activities

- Annual *24 Hour Rosary*, which includes Eucharistic Adoration, praying for the end to abortion, and *Mass for Life*.
- Participation in the *March for Life* in Washington D.C. Each January.
- Rosary recitation after the Saturday 8:30 a.m. Mass for the protection for those unborn babies whose lives are threatened by abortion.
- Guest speakers on Natural Family Planning.
- Talks on abstinence to teenagers in the parish's religious education program.
- Support for *Problem Pregnancy*, *Visitation House*, *Spring House* and other important ministries.
- Participation in local respect life events.
- Annual essay contest for 7th & 8th graders in St. Mary's School & Religious Education program on the topics of abortion, the disabled and euthanasia.
- Participation in the 40 Days for Life campaign.
- Project Rachel - an outreach ministry of the Catholic Church to women
- and men who are hurting from a past abortion.

Who We Are

We are stewards of our time. In 1973 when the United States Supreme Court legalized abortion in America, a group of St. Mary's parishioners got together to see how we could advocate for the right to life of the unborn. Key figures in this group were former Massachusetts Supreme Court Justice Francis P. O'Connor and his wife Ann, Dr. Robert Blute and his wife Ann Marie, Attorney John Connors and his wife and Ann and Dr. John Harding along with his wife Grace.
