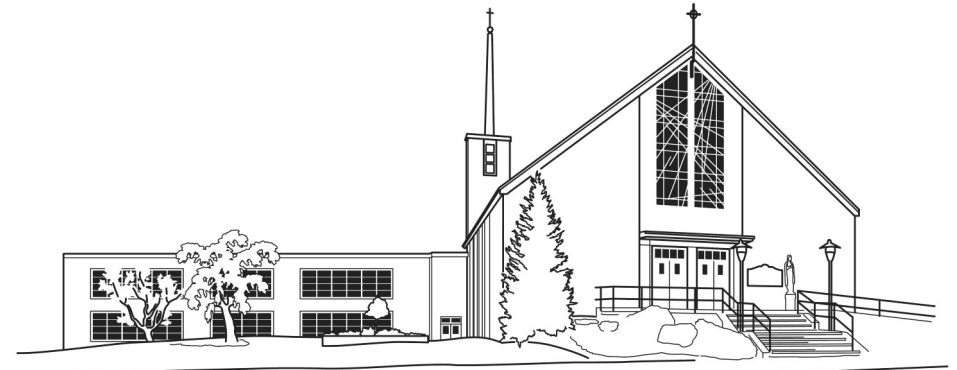

- \* Supporting the school administrators as requested throughout the year.

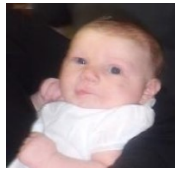

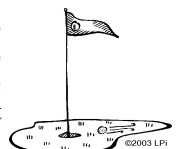
